Now above said fruits are not seen in the forest, in future generation they may not get fruits of those kind, Forest replantations, Bio-Diversity register, demerits of deforestation, Pollution leading to worst situation in our country, globally for this matter. To live we need Air, Water, Fire, Space and earth these things are very much important to live, anything goes wrong with above said there will be some problem to living beings. It is a alarming situation now we are facing, If it continues for a longer time hardly we see any living being on the earth, and encourage Non-pesticide management, ban plastic related all types of covers, motivate to take up composted pit and bio gas plants and use of solar in the villages.

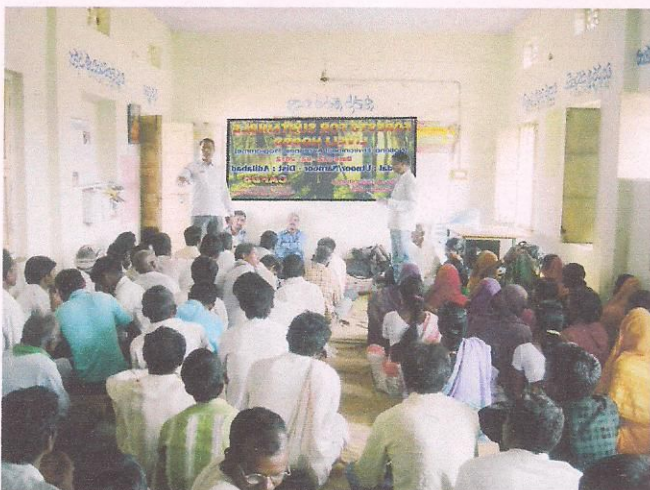

## 5. Action component: Home waste (House hold waste compost)

The wastage can be use in agricultural fields like home made wastage and animals dung, grass will be used in the compost pits. That is very important and very usefull in agricultural cultivation the systematic manner also explained by mr.Samuel raj M.Sc., B.Ed. and mr.Gokul has explained about waste usages in the fields of agriculture and nutrients to the crops and costs and margins to the farmers. The production of composts pits preparation is not known the systematic manner of programs which will be very useful to the farmers. And the subsidies for the seed and instruments are explained what are availabilities in the agricultural offices.
