The following Activities are taken up for the Year, 2013-14.

### **1.Vocational training & Lively hood programmes :-**

Under the head of this programme we have given training in Beautician, Tailoring & Embroidery. It is a one year course and first six month we have given tailoring in Tailoring and another Six Months we have given Beautician and Machine embroidery nearly 386 women were benefited in this programme at 3 mandals of Adilabad District.



### **2.Livelihood Programmes:-**

**Agarbathi sticks making & Leaf Plates making training programme:**

Motivating the people towards livelihood education is the most Important and cruel objective of CAPDS. Our NGO Woks with this Objective of improving the quality of life in the rural and agency areas.

Life in the rural and agency areas particularly the poor and socially disadvantaged sections of society. CAPDS conducted many livelihood trainings to improve the poor people life style. Thus people below the poverty line. People belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes, banded labour, women and people with disabilities are priority four groups for ready.

Our Organization Organized Agarbathi Sticks, leaf plates making for women and youth. Nearby 685 members were trained in these courses. They are all now getting self employment by different private sectors. We mobilized materials and costumers from different areas. We succeed to get Agarbathi Sticks, leave plates making machines as loans for our beneficiaries from forest Department & IKP.



### 3. Child labour programme & JJB Act 2000

**Child labour programme:-** Under the head of this programme we have identified Some of the child labour working in automobile workshops, hotels, Brick making.

328 children were rescued from child labour and dropout children main streamed into school. Some children restored to the family.

482 Street children Begging Rag picker were counseled and restored to the family



#### **4.A District level Work Shop on effective Implementation of Juvenile Justice Act 2000:-**

We conducted in Adilabad District level work shop an effective implementation of Juvenile justice Act. 2000 TTDC Adilabad District.

We have to observe why the children dropped on the middle of the education we should to conduct the interactions a longs with questionnaire with the health environment and education line department on the situation of the children in Adilabad District, and also mainly stressed on the following paints.



**5.MEDICAL & HEALTH CAMPS: -** Under the head of this programme we have conducted Medical Camps in coordination with Rajiv Arogya Sree Scheme. We have identified chronic diseases

patients and referred to concerned hospitals for treatment. And for normal a seasonal diseases we have distributed medicines and free of cost. We have distributed medicines and free of cost. At out targeted Villages and propagated the importance of balanced nutritious diet for the good health of children at out targeted areas of villages in agency mandals of Adilabad District in Telangana.

**6.RICE, NOTE BOOKS DISTRIBUTION:-** CAPDS helped to the Tribal/SC Poor Peoples who lost their houses with Tufans. Then our organization helped to the tribal/SC Poor Students Distribution Note Books & Rice Distributed.
